HE DIED THE DEATH WE SHOULD HAVE DIED

Why is the cross a big deal and why do we call the day something so bad happened on, 'Good Friday?'

On the cross, God did to Jesus what He should have done to us for what we have done to Him. Jesus took the punishment we deserve for our sins by dying on the cross so that we could be forgiven of our sin and brought into a relationship with God. Without the cross, we would be separated from God forever. We should respond to this in one of two ways: 1) repent and place our faith in Jesus if you haven't yet, or 2) you should be filled with gratitude and worship Jesus for His sacrifice.

Questions to think about or discuss: Why is the cross a big deal? How do you need to personally respond to what Jesus did for you this week?

HE WAS RAISED TO LIFE SO WE COULD LIVE

Jesus did die for our sins. But He didn't stay dead! He rose from the grave, conquering death and the grave. Why is this a big deal?

First, because Jesus rose from the grave, one day, so will we. We don't have to fear death because we know that it isn't the last word on us. We will live forever with God. Second, because Jesus rose from the grave, we can live a new life starting now. If we have a relationship with Jesus, we will go to heaven when we die. but we can also begin living the life He died and rose from the grave to give us here and now.

Questions to think about or discuss: Why is the resurrection of Jesus a big deal?
Would you say you're living the life Jesus died and rose to give you? If not, what's keeping you from doing that?
