READ ROMANS 12:2 DAY 1

A few years ago, everyone was wearing bracelets that said "WWJD." What Would Jesus Do? While the bracelets were a fad that has passed, the idea behind them is a good one—when you're trying to figure out what to do in any situation, asking yourself what Jesus would do is a great idea! Nearly everything that Jesus did was opposite of the popular choice, so there will be times when you have to choose a different route from your friends.

Find a place to write WWJD (your hand, your notebook, the hallway mirror) so you will see it and remember to choose what Jesus would do.

KNOW that God's way is good and perfect.

READ COLOSSIANS 3:17, 23

DAY 2

When you get ready in the morning, just do half of what you normally do. Comb one side of your hair. Brush one side of your teeth. Put on one sock and one shoe.

Now go back and go all in. Brush all of your hair, every tooth in your mouth, and lace up both sneakers.

DAY 3

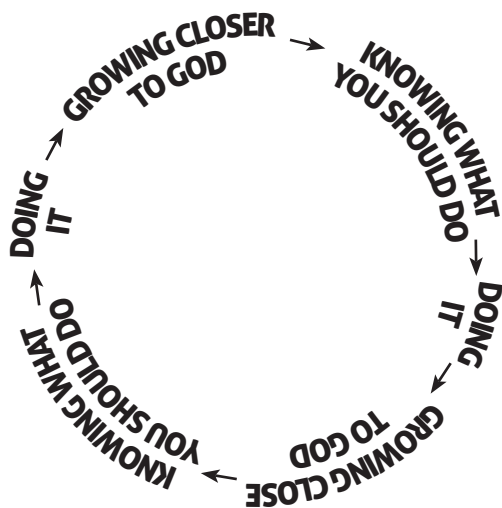
When you live your life for God, others WILL notice. And it will give you a chance to tell them about the God who made them and loves them and wants them to be a part of His family.

Make a cross because Jesus died for our sins. Make a circle like the sun because you can shine God's love to everyone. Feel free to make up your own shapes as you talk about how you can be the light of the world

READ COLOSSIANS 1:9-10

DAY 4
