Activity: Emotions

BIBLE STORY

Prodigal Son
(Luke 15:11-24)

REMEMBER THIS

“Nothing at all can ever separate us from God’s love.”
Romans 8:39, NIV

SAY THIS

Who loves you?
God loves me.

WHAT YOU NEED:

Paper plates, marker

WHAT YOU DO:

Draw different emotion faces (like emojis) on the paper plates. Hold up the different prepared faces and talk about what makes you sad, happy, scared, or excited. Ask your child what makes him feel those emotions. Remind your child that God loves us no matter what.

WHAT YOU SAY:

“God loves us when we are happy, sad, excited, or scared. God loves us all the time. **Who loves you? God loves me.**”
